When Nick was a baby, the doctors discovered he couldn't see. It hadn't mattered much when he was little. He thought everyone was like him, living in a world of total blackness. As he grew older he began to realize he was different. People talked about trees, flowers, the sky, and the sea, but Nick had no idea what they meant. When he was five he began to read Braille and that was better. He loved stories and he could live in a different world.
Nick's parents weren't very nice to him. They made him do all sorts of very difficult things, by himself. They made him learn to do things on his own, like his younger brother who could see! It was agonizing for Nick.
One day, when Nick was outside playing soccer with his brother and a few friends, the other boys made him goalie, and then they began kicking the ball straight at Nick as hard as they could. Since he could never see it coming, Nick could not get out of the way. Again and again the ball hit him straight in the chest, or on the face, or on his knees. In the end, he ran home crying. His mom hugged him, but she sent him out again. Nick never enjoyed soccer after that.

Nick grew up not liking other people much, even his own family. People had been unkind to Nick, teasing him and abusing him. But it made him strong and tough, and he didn't care what other people thought of him. One day he heard about Jesus, who had healed a blind man, just like Nick, he had been born blind. Nick knew he wanted to follow Jesus for the rest of his life.
